

## **Spokane Falls Community College Academic Standards Office – Office of the Registrar**

Students who meet the following criteria will be required to follow these procedures

**A1 – Warning.** The first quarter a student's quarterly GPA falls below a 2.0. If the student does not achieve a 2.0 or better quarterly GPA the next enrolled quarter, then the student will be placed on A2 Academic Probation.

**A2 – Probation.** This is the second quarter in a row a student has failed to earn a 2.0 or better quarterly GPA. The student is blocked from registration activity until the student has met with a faculty counselor or attended an approved workshop. Any student who has received two consecutive quarters of zero's (0.0), will be required to attend a College Prep class before returning to regular academic classes.

**A3 – Suspension.** This is the third quarter in a row the student has failed to achieve a 2.0 or better quarterly GPA. The A3 status suspends students for one quarter unless they choose to attend a College Prep class. If the student attends College Prep and is successful, the student will be reinstated at an A2 status (Probation).

**A4 – Final Suspension.** This is the fourth and final quarter a student has failed to earn a 2.0 or better quarterly GPA. Final Suspension requires a student to sit out one calendar year (four quarters) before they may apply to be reinstated. The A4 student does have the option of attending a College Prep class for one quarter. If the student is successful, the student will be allowed to return to school after one quarter; lifting the one year suspension.

### **IMPORTANT NOTE:**

The Academic Standards Procedures are SEPARATE from those of the Financial Aid Office. Financial Aid recipients must maintain satisfactory academic progress (SAP) to continue receiving financial assistance.
