

# Which Test Do I Take?

## MATH LITERACY

**-OR-**

## ALGEBRA INTENSIVE

You will take the MATH LITERACY pathway if you are intending to pursue the following majors/subject areas:

- ✓ AAS/AAS-T degrees at SFCC which require a specific math class (consult program guide for your degree)
- ✓ Communications/Journalism and Modern Languages
- ✓ English
- ✓ Fine Arts (including Art/Art History, Drama, Music)
- ✓ Health Sciences (Occupational Therapy/Dental Hygiene...)
- ✓ Pre-Law
- ✓ Nursing/BSN (four year degree)
- ✓ Philosophy
- ✓ Physical Education (PE)
- ✓ Secondary Education (except math and science teachers)
- ✓ Social Sciences (including Anthropology, History, Political, Psychology, Social Work, Sociology)
- ✓ BAS

### **IMPORTANT!!**

Graduation from a four year school usually requires one math course beyond Math 88. Math 107 will meet this requirement if a SPECIFIC math class is not required for your major.

You will take the ALGEBRA INTENSIVE pathway if you are intending to pursue the following majors/subject areas:

- ✓ Architecture
- ✓ Business (includes: Accounting, Business Administration, Economics, Marketing...)
- ✓ Computer Science
- ✓ Elementary Education (K-8 only)
- ✓ Engineering
- ✓ Mathematics
- ✓ Physical Therapy
- ✓ Pre Med/Dental
- ✓ Life & Physical Sciences (includes Astronomy, Biology, Chemistry, Geology, Physics...)
