

## ANGEL Accessibility Features

ANGEL meets the requirements of Section 508 of the United States Rehabilitation Act. ANGEL includes an Accessibility Wizard that you can use to create profiles to meet your personal needs and also supports the Accessibility for Learner Information Packages (ACCLIP) specification, which allows you to import existing accessibility profiles from other systems into your ANGEL account.



To utilize ANGEL's accessibility features, click the **508 Accessibility** icon located in the lower left corner of the home page. From the **Accessibility Menu**, you can either create a profile or add a profile to ANGEL by uploading ACCLIP files.
