

**PreCalculus Agreement**  
**Using High School PreCalculus for CCS Math Placement**

Those students who present a high school transcript documenting an A or B (3.0 or better) in the full annual sequence of Precalculus can receive **conditional placement** into Math 107, 108, 141, 201, 208, 211 or 221 upon their request.

Students with an A (4.0) in the full annual high school Precalculus sequence may enroll in Math 107, 108, 141, 201, 208, 211, 221; or 151 upon their request under the same conditional placement.

The conditions of these placements are as follows:

1. Students who wish to take advantage of this placement must *complete* the appropriate course within one calendar year of graduating from high school. Otherwise, students must proceed through the regular placement process.
2. If they do not receive a 2.0 or higher in their **first** math course selected using this conditional placement (**Math 107, 108, 141, 201, 208, 211, 221, or 151**), the students must proceed through the regular placement process before taking any math course, Phil & 120 or any other course that has a math prerequisite.
3. This process adheres with the placement reciprocity agreement policy for WA state.

## High School Pre Calculus Agreement Spokane Falls Community College Math Placement

By providing Spokane Falls Community College with a high school transcript documenting an A or B (3.0 or better) in both semesters of Pre-Calculus, the Math placement is advisory and you may receive placement in any course up to Math 151 (Calculus I). The following conditions apply:

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand this placement is good for only one year immediately after I graduate from high school. After the first year, placement testing is required prior to registration for any Math course at SFCC.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand this placement is only applicable to the first Math course in which I register. If I do not complete and/or pass my first \*Math course with a 2.0 (letter grade of a C) or better, I must complete the Math placement testing process.

\_\_\_\_\_ An average letter grade of an 'A' (4.0) in high school Pre-Calculus allows placement in and up to Math 151. An average letter grade of an 'A-' permits placement in and up to Math 142. An average letter grade of a 'B' permits placement in and up to Math 141.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that while this placement will satisfy the Intermediate Algebra Proficiency of the A.A. degree upon successful completion of a transfer level Math course, it will not fulfill any other requirement of the degree nor grant college-level credit.

I have read and comprehend the above agreement. I also understand the processes and procedures for the Math Placement Pre-Calculus Agreement.

\* Pre Calculus you must complete two semesters of high school Pre-Calculus with an average letter grade of a 'B' or better for placement into a college level Math or Pre Calculus course. You must complete two semesters of high school Pre Calculus, and earn an average letter grade of an 'A' (4.0) for placement into Math 151 Calculus.
